ORDER

Shri Girisha P.S, a person with 90% locomotor disability filed a complaint dated 30.03.2013 in the Court of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities under the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, hereinafter referred to as Act regarding allocation of home cadre to candidates with disabilities of Indian Administrative Service.

2. The complainant submitted that he secured All India 3rd rank in overall person with disabilities category and 1st in OBC with persons with disabilities category in 2012 batch. He submitted that DoP&T declared the cadre allocation of 2012 batch. As per cadre allocation policy 2008, he was allotted Assam-Meghalaya cadre.
3. The matter was taken up with the Secretary, Deptt. of Personnel and Training vide this Court's letter dated 01.08.2013 followed by reminder letters dated 27.09.2013, 15.05.2015, 19.10.2016 and 02.12.2016.



5. During the hearing, none appeared on behalf of the Complainant and Respondent nor any intimation has been received about their inability to attend the hearing despite the fact that the Notice of Hearing was sent on 30.01.2017 by Speed Post.

6. In the light of Rule 42(4) of the Persons with Disabilities Rules, 1996, the complaint is dismissed in default as devoid of merits.
